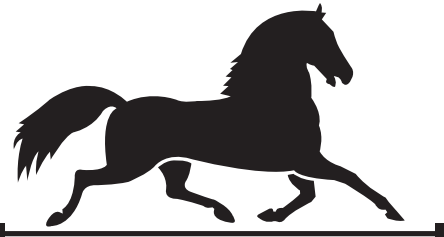

PLEASURE HORSE/PONY (2')

Open to horses and ponies.

PONY HUNTER (2')

Class maybe be split by pony size, if there are enough entries.

JUNIOR EQUITATION (2')

Open to riders under the age of 18 as of Jan. 1, 2010.

MODIFIED HUNTER (2'3")

Open to horses and ponies.

CROSS ROAD TACK MEDAL (2'6")

Open to riders of all ages. Judged on hands, seat and control of mount. Top riders may be asked back for hack.

LOW HUNTER (2'6")

Open to horses and ponies.

EQUITATION: Rider judged on hands, seat and control of mount.

HUNTER: Horse judged on manner performance and way of going.

LO-MAR FARM SPORTSMANSHIP

Open to all Junior Riders riding or not. Register to get an armband. The winner will exhibit good sportsmanship to at the horse show. Winner is determined by the show manager.

JUDGED SCHOOLING ROUND

Can be ridden before any jumping round in the afternoon session, *EXCEPT MEDAL*. Must specify at Gate as schooling round.

1. Approved helmets are mandatory for all riders at all times while mounted and exhibitors are to be suitably attired. **Proper attire is required. (HUNTER: Boots, Breeches, Shirt & Jacket JUMPERS: Boots, Breeches and Collared Shirt)**
2. Management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel or change the order of classes if necessary. Judge's decision is final.
3. Negative coggins within one year required.
4. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class, with ribbon to the division champion and reserve.
5. If you cannot leave your dog at home, please keep it on a leash.
6. All Cross Road Tack Shows are run in accordance with current USEF rules.
