Show Jumping: course will consist of 9-11 jumps at a height of 2'7" may include 1 combination.

NOVICE

Dressage: USEA Novice Test A

Show Jumping: course will consist of 9-11 jumps at a height of 2'11" to include 1 combination.

TRAINING

Dressage: USEA Training Test A

Show Jumping: course will consist of 10-12 jumps at a maximum height of 3'3" to include at least 1 combination.
